1. AUTHORITY

1.1 Chapter 46, Houston Code of Ordinances

2. PURPOSE/POLICY STATEMENT

2.1 Under the provisions of Chapter 46 of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances (Chapter 46), applicants for a pedicab operator's permit must submit a uniform color scheme for their vehicles. The purpose of this requirement is to allow enforcement officers and the riding public to more easily identify licensed operators.

3. PROCEDURES

- 4.1 No permittee or driver shall drive or cause to be driven any pedicab in the city until the permittee has filed with the director (or designee), for approval, the color scheme that he proposes to use under his ownership.
- 4.2 In approving or disapproving the color scheme submitted, the director or his designee shall consider:
 - a) The color scheme presently in use by the permittee, if any;
 - b) The color schemes of other permittees;
 - d) Which permittee first used or requested approval of the color scheme.
- 4.3 If the color scheme is approved, the permittee shall, within 15 days, deliver to the director or his designee, a color photograph of his pedicab color scheme, and shall not change the color scheme without the approval of the director.
- 4.5 If the color scheme is approved, the permittee shall apply the color scheme uniformly across all pedicab vehicles operated by the permittee.
