To more accurately paint a picture of BARC's outcomes and intakes, BARC will be reporting our At-A-Glance narrative on a quarterly basis. From January through March, BARC saw a slight increase in its live release rate. During this time frame, BARC continued to host offsite events and one of the largest events of the year, ABC 13 and Gilman Subaru's Pick Your Pet adoption event. At this year's adoption event, a record-breaking 153 animals found their forever homes. This year's event was especially helpful for capacity as many large dogs were adopted.

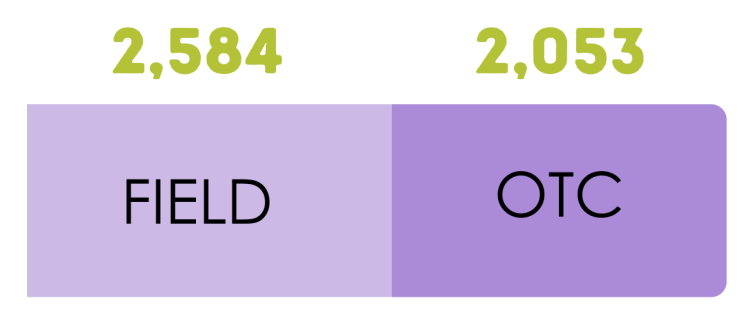
## 84.2% TOTAL SAVE RATE

Save Rate = The percentage of animals who leave the shelter through adoption, return to owner, transfers to other organizations, or other lifesaving program

Intake continues with the trend of mainly comprising animals brought in by our enforcement team from the field. This quarter, around 55% of requests were filled. We saw in 2023 that calls for service continued to rise, so this is not a surprise as we continue to require intake appointments for stray turn in and owner surrenders. Sick, injured, or fading animals never require an appointment.

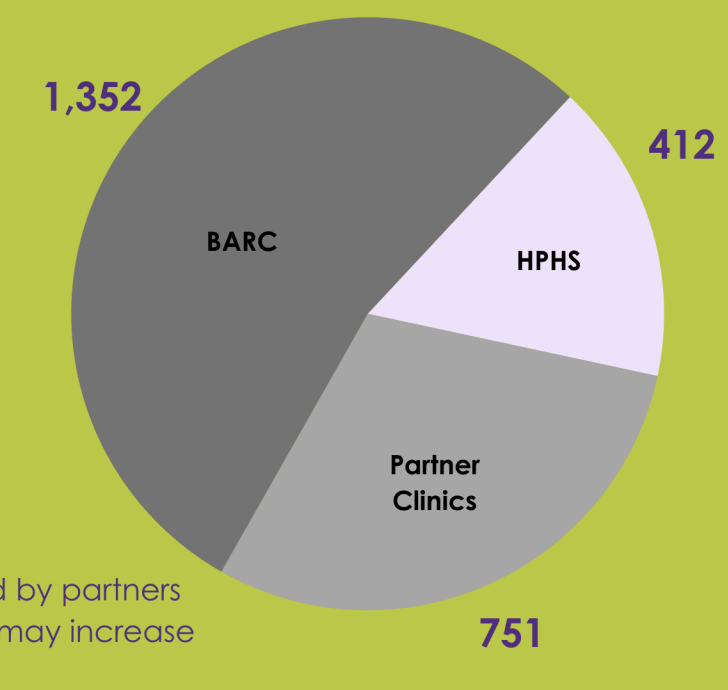

BARC's twice-a-week extended hours to 7 p.m. every week have greatly benefited these areas, specifically.
