


TrackSafe: A Multimodal Culture of Safety

Mobility & Grade Separations

- **Installed fencing near Milby High** to direct pedestrians to the protected Broadway St. crossing.
- **Upgraded sidewalk** along Broadway St. near Milby.
- Coordinating with TxDOT, City of Houston, and HISD on pedestrian bridges near Milby High and McReynolds Middle.
- Sponsoring design for McReynolds Middle pedestrian overpass and pursuing construction funding with local and state partners.
- Conducted crossing safety evaluations at schools near railroads and developing a safe routes plan with HISD.
