Proposition A Council Member Item:
Prevention of Median and Roadway Blockage

Summary: ORDINANCE to prevent people from standing in the medians and roadways.

Background: Section 26-90 of the Houston Code of Ordinances prevents people from leaving animals or vehicles on medians, but does not prevent pedestrians from standing and walking on them.

Specific Explanation: This ordinance would prevent pedestrians from standing on medians or divided roadways.

Proposal:

Section 26-90 (1) of the Houston Code of Ordinances shall be replaced with the following:

It shall be unlawful for any person to stand or walk; ride, operate, leave unattended any animal and/or livestock or park any vehicle on, over or across any esplanade, median strip or traffic island.
