Policing Analytics & Transparency HUB



**A unified, interactive reporting platform**



**Real-time and scheduled data updates**



**Enhanced filtering and drill-down capabilities**



**Cross-dataset analytics (Stops, Force, Discipline, Diversity)**



PATH is designed to **modernize** how transparency data is accessed, analyzed, and understood.




# The Legacy Police Transparency HUB (ArcGIS)

- Multiple separate dashboard pages
- Static or semi-static visualizations
- Limited cross-dashboard interaction
- Map-centered reporting structure



The Legacy HUB provided public visibility but limited integrated analysis.

# Why was **PATH** developed?



The transition reflects a modernization effort to move from **static reporting** to **dynamic analysis**.

# How is PATH working today?

- ✓ Dynamic Filtering across multiple data elements
- ✓ Drill-down capability (year → category → incident type)
- ✓ Cross-visual filtering (clicking one chart updates all others)
- ✓ Multi-Year Trend Visualization
- ✓ Automated Scheduled Data Refreshes
- ✓ Improved performance and responsiveness





 Data Visualization	Map-focused publishing environment	▶ Unified analytics and reporting environment
 Filtering & Analysis	Static charts and maps	▶ Interactive dashboards with drill-down capability
 Decision Support	Dashboard-specific filtering	▶ Cross-dashboard filtering and comparative analysis
 Filtering & Analysis	Manual or periodic updates	▶ Automated, scheduled data refresh capability
 Decision Support	Limited longitudinal analysis	▶ Multi-year dynamic trend visualization
 Decision Support	Datasets displayed separately	▶ Linked datasets within a single analytic framework
 Decision Support	Snapshot-based reporting	▶ Governance-ready analytics supporting oversight

# Data Integration in PATH

Integrates multiple transparency datasets:

-  Traffic Stops
-  Use of Force
-  Type of Force
-  Disciplinary Actions
-  Workforce Diversity




# Our Vision
