ORDER ADOPTING A YOUTH DIVERSION PLAN

The City of Houston has established its Youth Diversion Program and hereby adopts this Plan which has been authorized by Chapter 45, subchapter E of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure (C.C.P) and is contingent on the eligibility of the child and the child shall be diverted from formal criminal prosecution through this Youth Diversion Program.

Subchapter E provides for judicial diversion after a charge involving a child is filed and after a finding or verdict of guilt in the trial of a child, whether the trial is a bench trial or jury trial. Judicial diversion may not exceed 180 days under Art. 45.310, C.C.P. The child must be eligible for diversion. A child is eligible for diversion under subchapter E only once every 365 days. A child is not eligible for diversion if the child previously had an unsuccessful diversion under subchapter E or if the prosecutor objects to the diversion. (Art. 45.304, C. C. P. A child may not be diverted from criminal prosecution without the consent of the child and the child's parent or guardian, and the child is at least 10 years of age and younger than 17 years of age.

The Youth Diversion Plan allows a child the opportunity to complete a plan designed to assist the child by having realistic and reasonable terms set by the Municipal Court Judge which are listed on our Diversion Agreement. The requirements will be set by the Judge and fully explained to the child, parents or guardians and will be designed with the best interest of the child in mind to prevent formal criminal prosecution, encourage the child to accept responsibility for their actions and consequences, deter future criminal conduct, reduce reoccurrence of problematic behavior, reduce recidivism and serve to redirect at-risk youth.

The Houston Municipal Courts are committed to justice for our youth in Houston and our surrounding areas should the need arise. We understand that each child that enters our courts is unique with different needs, and they will be assessed on an individual basis. The best interest of the child is the central focus of this Youth Diversion Plan.

All records of a diversion pertaining to a child under Subchapter E shall be expunged without the requirement of a motion or request on the child's 18th birthday.

This order and a copy of the Diversion Agreement, additional forms associated with the Youth Diversion Plan as well as any future forms or orders shall be posted on our website and available for public inspection.

This document constitutes a Diversion Agreement between the Municipal Court of Houston (Municipal Court) and (Parent). This Diversion

The objectives of this agreement are entered into with consideration of the circumstances of the child, the best interests of the child, and the long-term safety of the community.
