LEAD WARNING STATEMENT

Every applicant/occupant/homeowner with any interest in residential/commercial real property on which a residential/commercial dwelling was built prior to 1978 is notified that such property may present exposure to lead from lead-based paint that may place young children at risk of developing lead poisoning. Lead poisoning in young children may produce permanent neurological damage, including learning disabilities, reduced intelligence quotient, behavioral problems, and impaired memory. Lead poisoning also poses a particular risk to pregnant women. If the Housing & Community Development Department (HCD) is involved in the sale or has an interest in residential/commercial real property, HCD is required to provide the applicant/occupant/homeowner with any information on lead-based paint hazards from risk assessments or inspections, in HCD's possession and notify the applicant/occupant/homeowner of any known lead-based paint hazards. A risk assessment or inspection for possible lead-based paint hazards is recommended prior to the applicant/occupant/homeowner occupying such property.

SECTION 1: ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF LEAD BASED PAINT NOTICE

The booklet “[Protect Your Family from Lead in Your Home](https://www.epa.gov/lead/protect-your-family-lead-your-home-english)” (<https://www.epa.gov/lead/protect-your-family-lead-your-home-english>) explains the dangers of Lead-Based Paint and the steps you can take to protect your family.



NOTE: 40 CFR 745.85 (a) states that the pamphlet “Protect Your Family from Lead in Your Home” must be delivered to the applicant/occupant/homeowner no more than 60 days in advance of any renovation activity.
