The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing an ordinance authorizing a Second Amendment to the Developer Agreement between the City's Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) Program and Change Happens Community Development Corporation (CDC), allocating up to \$340,000.00 in additional HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) set-aside funds to cover construction cost increases from the original Developer Agreement.

The initial Developer Agreement authorized the development of up to nine (9) affordable single-family homes. The City and Change Happens CDC desire to amend the Developer Agreement and relevant provisions, exhibits, and related documents to increase funding from \$2,100,000.00 to \$2,440,000.00 in HOME set-aside funds to cover construction cost increases.

The CHDO Program administers newly constructed affordable-family homes for sale to eligible low- and moderate-income homebuyers; and expands nonprofit housing providers' capacity.

The public has thirty (30) days to comment on these proposed items. The thirty-day period extends from Tuesday, July 16, 2024, through Friday, August 16, 2024.
