The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) is proposing approval of an Ordinance authorizing a First Amendment to the Agreement between the City and Houston Community College System District (HCC). This amendment will add additional locations to the original scope of work and add line items that were not included in the original budget. No changes will be made to the total funding amount of \$459,209.09, which is comprised of Department of Labor – Community Project Funding and American Rescue Plan Act funds.

The EmPowering Solar Jobs Program (Program) is a workforce development program focused on providing STEM career opportunities to residents without college degrees. The Program offers training in electrical technician or solar installer certificate programs, purchase instructional supplies, and provides case management services for 100 participants.
