matter. An immediate family member of a City employee, whose duties are designated to HCDD, has applied to receive Community Development Block Grant assistance through the City's Home Repair Program.

HCDD is filing a request with the United States Housing and Urban Development Department for an exception to the conflict of interest prohibition under 24 CFR 570.611(d), provided that the recipient of funds, has satisfactorily met the threshold requirements as follows:
