

CDBG Public Notice

The City of Houston's (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) is proposing Substantial Amendments to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) budgets in the 2021, 2022, and 2023 Annual Action Plans.

These amendments will:

1. Transfer \$66,693.65 of unexpended CDBG funding from Lead-Based Paint to the Economic Development activity within the 2021 Annual Action Plan.
2. Transfer \$197,620.41 of unexpended CDBG funding from Code Enforcement and Public Facilities to the Economic Development activity within the 2022 Annual Action Plan.
3. Transfer \$798,799.56 of unexpended CDBG funding from Public Facilities to the Economic Development activity within the 2023 Annual Action Plan.

In accordance with HUD's Citizen Participation Plan regulations, the City is required to amend components of its Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan for a variety of reasons, including when a reallocation of funds increases or decreases the budget of an activity by more than 25% or when an activity is added or deleted in the Plan(s).
