Background

In furtherance of Mayor Annise Parker's commitment to ensure the success of small, minority, women, and disadvantaged business enterprises (S/MWDBEs), the Office of Business Opportunity (OBO) is charged with creating a competitive and diverse business environment in the City of Houston by promoting the growth and success of these historically underutilized businesses, through their meaningful participation in the government procurement process. This progress is measured, in part, by monitoring the extent of these groups' participation on City contracts.

In compliance with Chapter 15, Article V of the City Code of Ordinances, this report details the progress city departments have made in attaining the utilization goals established for the City's S/MWDBE program. In addition, for the purpose of reporting all certified firms awarded contracts managed by the City, this report also includes the amount awarded to certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) who participated in United States Department of Transportation funded contracts.

S/MWDBE Awards Summary

In FY2013, the City of Houston awarded \$1,061,287,625 to firms for construction, professional services, and purchasing agreements. However from this amount, \$120,860,778 were exempt contracts and \$29,411,677 were non-goal oriented contracts. Neither of these contract types require the utilization of certified firms, therefore the total dollar amount awarded on goal-oriented contracts was \$911,015,169. From this amount \$233,784,659 was awarded to certified small, minority, women and disadvantaged business enterprises, which amounts to a utilization rate of 25.7%.

When S/MWDBE awards are analyzed by **ethnicity**, Hispanic-owned certified firms received 31.2% (\$73,052,041) of the total amount awarded. Certified Black-owned firms were awarded 18.3% (\$42,783,130). Asian-owned certified firms represented 19.7% (\$45,996,089) of dollars awarded. Other Ethnicity-owned certified firms were awarded 16.8% (\$39,224,229). Typically the "Other Ethnicity" category includes participants of the SBE program. This category includes white males as well as all other non-minority classifications. Caucasian Women-owned certified firms were awarded 11.7% (\$27,238,156). Native American-owned certified firms earned 2.3% (\$5,491,013) of all dollars awarded. The total number of awards to certified firms was 5,751. The following represents the number of awards by ethnicity: Hispanics – 1,413, Blacks – 1,213, Caucasian Women – 1,222, Asians – 1,415, Other Ethnicities – 317 and Native Americans – 171.

When S/MWDBE awards are analyzed by **contract type**, certified S/MWDBE firms were awarded \$135,917,424 for construction, which is 28.2% of the total amount of \$482,177,952 awarded in all city-related construction projects. A total of \$53,569,984 was awarded to certified firms for professional services, which is 39.9% of all professional services contracts awarded citywide. A total of \$44,297,252 was awarded to certified firms on purchasing projects, which is 15.0% of all purchasing amounts awarded citywide.

Availability of Certified Firms

As stated above, the awards for exempt contracts totals \$120,860,778. This amount includes contracts valued at \$89,443,945 that were either approved by OBO for a goal waiver or whose goals were waived pursuant to the terms of an intergovernmental agreement. From this amount, OBO approved three contracting department's request to waive the goal on a contracts due to the unavailability of certified firms which included the following: an aerial, ground ladder and testing services contract for \$244,941; a maintenance agreement of IT related contract of \$1,322,166; and a contract for the purchase of surface materials for playgrounds and jogging trails for \$256,669 for Houston Parks & Recreation Department. Additional certified firms are needed in these areas to participate on contract opportunities. Please see page 32-33 for more details.

In addition, OBO granted contracting departments request to reduce the goal for six contracts with limited certified firms available. One contract was for fire and security alarm system maintenance, inspection, testing and monitoring services, totaling \$6,175,400. Another was moving and storage of household goods for the Housing and Community Development department, with a reduced goal due to limited certified firms available, which totaled \$222,000. A third was for the repair/rehabilitation of wastewater treatment plant blowers in the amount of \$3,584,540. There were also, contracts for scientific products for various departments for \$4,294,287, a contract for formal bids received for security badging equipment in the amount of \$80,963.57, and one for submersible pumps totaling \$763,114. These six contracts have reduced goals but are still goal-oriented.





S/MWDBE Certification Types

Small Business Enterprise (SBE) certification is race and gender neutral, and applies only to eligible firms in the construction industry. SBE goals are typically applied only to construction related projects.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) certification applies to firms owned and operated by minorities. MBE goals may be applied to any locally funded contract type.

Women Business Enterprise (WBE) certification applies to firms owned and operated by females. WBE goals may be applied to locally funded non-construction related contracts.

Persons with Disabilities Business Enterprise (PDBE) certification applies to eligible firms owned and operated by individuals with an existing medically determined physical or mental impairment of a chronic or permanent character. PDBE utilization may be used to augment citywide goals set by City Council. Most PDBEs have multiple certification types. At the time that a contract is awarded, the prime contractor determines which certification type will be utilized. In most cases, PDBEs are utilized as a MBE or SBE.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) certification is a federal certification and applies to firms owned and operated by economically disadvantaged individuals. DBE goals apply only to U.S. Department of Transportation contracts that receive Federal financial assistance.

S/MWDBE Contract Types and Goals

There are three types of contract and non-contract projects: construction, professional services and purchasing. These projects can either be goal-oriented, which require S/MWDBE utilization, or non-goal-oriented, which do not require S/MWDBE utilization. The following are goal-oriented contract types and their annual citywide goals set by City Council for FY 2013.

Construction contracts are related to construction projects only. The citywide goal for construction projects is 22%.

Professional Services contracts require a professional license e.g. architect, engineer, attorney, or accountant etc. The citywide goal for professional services contracts is 24%.

Purchasing contracts provide for the supply of goods and non-personal or nonprofessional services. The citywide goal for purchasing contracts is 11%.

The following are subcategories under Purchasing contracts. These are non goal-oriented contract types and do not have citywide goals set by City Council. Note: the utilization of certified vendors on purchase orders and P-cards augments the citywide goal achievement percentage. Purchase orders and P-card purchases are included in the "purchasing total" in this report.

- **Purchase orders:** direct orders for various purchases made from vendors.
- **P-card purchases:** direct purchases from vendors using City of Houston purchasing cards

Exempt contracts are non goal-oriented and do not have assigned goals. The following reflects types of exempt contracts:

- **Emergency Contracts** - Contracts awarded due to an emergency to meet an immediate need.
- **Sole Source Contracts** - Contracts awarded to meet a need that can only be supplied from a firm that provides specialized and/or unique products or services.
- **Economic Burden** - Contracts that may not be financially feasible to award to a certified firm.
- **Waivers** - Contracts that are approved for a zero percent goal by the Office of Business Opportunity as defined by Chapter 15, Article v, Section 15-83. These contracts do not have S/MWDBEs available in the market to perform the work or the contract can not be divided to include the use of S/MWDBE subcontractors.

Non Goal-Oriented Contracts – Construction contracts \$1,000,000 or less and Purchasing contracts \$100,000 or less.

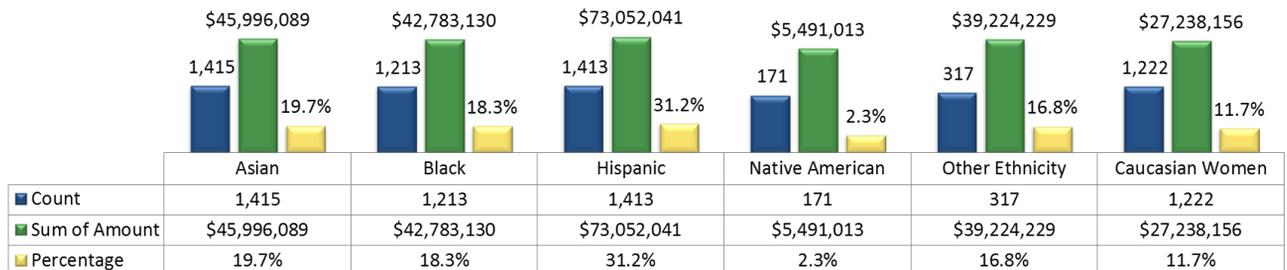

Administration and Regulatory Affairs

Details by Department

Jul 1, 2012 - Jun 30, 2013

- For FY2013, the Administration and Regulatory Affairs Department (ARA) awarded \$15,504,533 to certified and non-certified firms. However, from this amount \$98,750 was non goal-oriented. Approximately \$13,022,363 were exempt contracts. Out of the remaining \$2,383,420, a total of \$136,293, was awarded to certified firms, amounting to a 5.7% utilization.
- The purchasing total of \$2,133,420 included: \$1,226,860 for purchasing contracts, \$485,334 for purchase orders, and \$421,226 in p-card transactions.
- The exempt contracts total of \$13,022,363 included contracts where a waiver was granted by the Office of Business Opportunity.

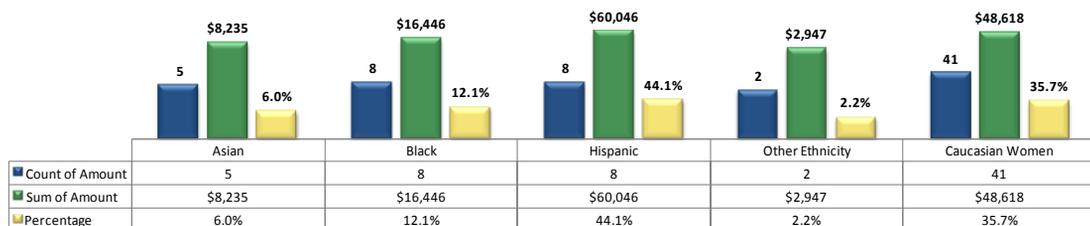

Details by Department

Jul 1, 2012 - Jun 30, 2013

- For FY2013, the Finance Department (FIN) awarded \$21,726,681, to certified and non-certified firms. However from this amount \$45,000 were non goal-oriented and \$100,901 were exempt contracts. Out of the remaining \$21,580,780, a total of \$3,171,806 was awarded to certified firms, amounting to a 14.7% utilization.
- The purchasing total of \$19,341,818 included: \$311,394 for purchase orders, \$19,000,004 for purchasing contracts, and \$30,420 in p-card transactions.
- Exempt contracts totaling \$100,901 were contracts without waivers.

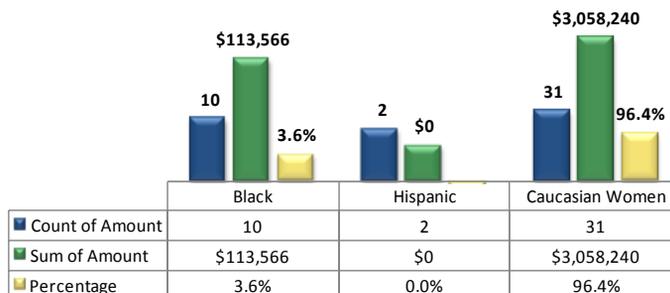

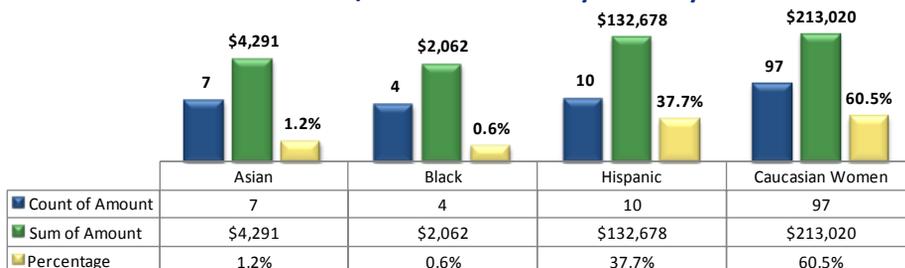

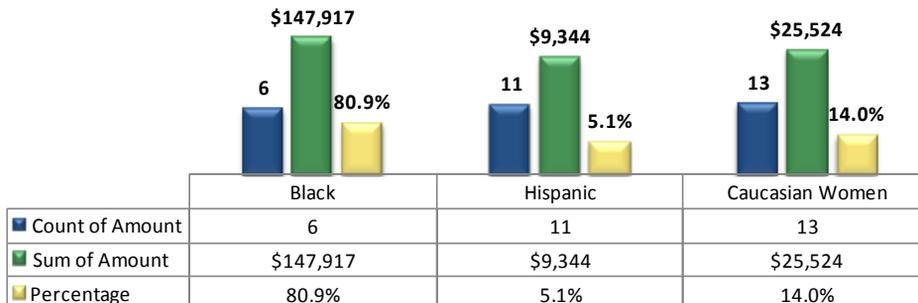

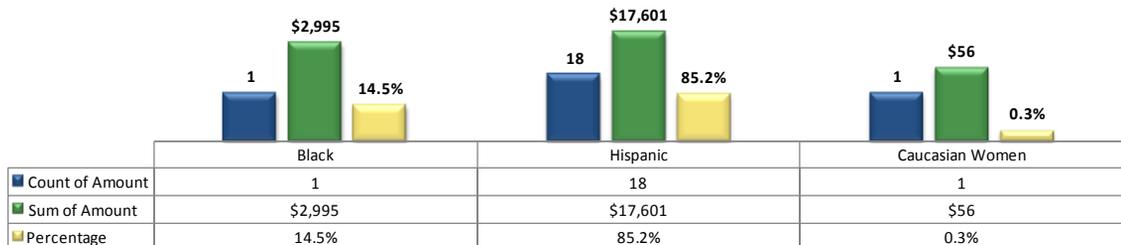

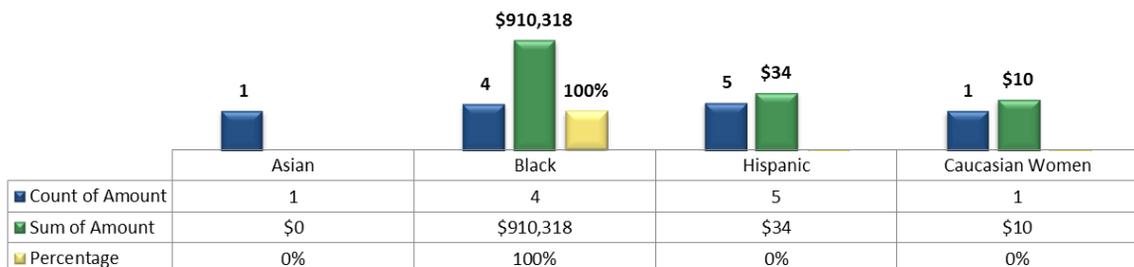

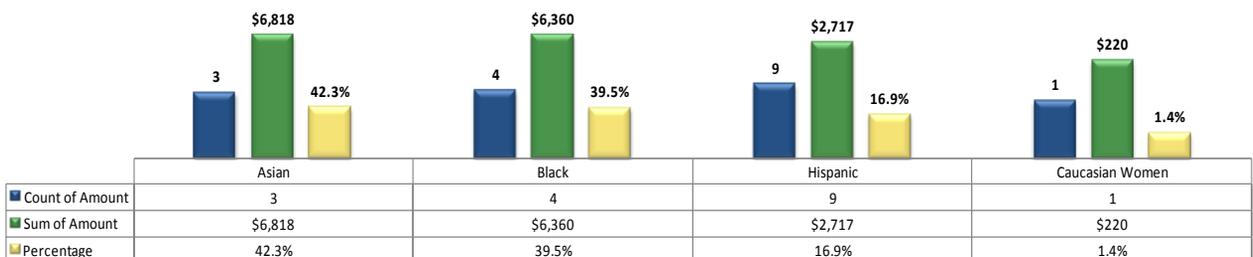

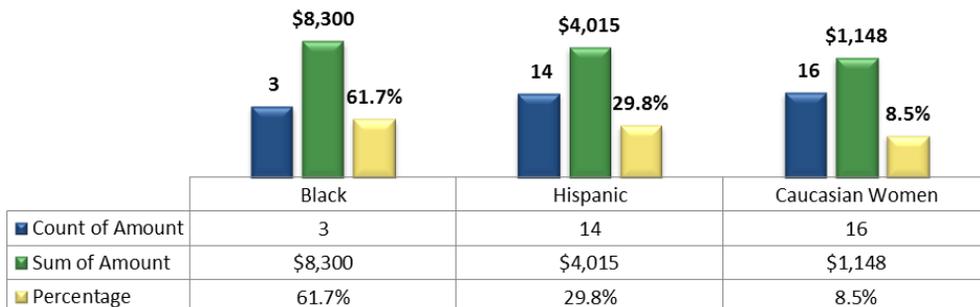

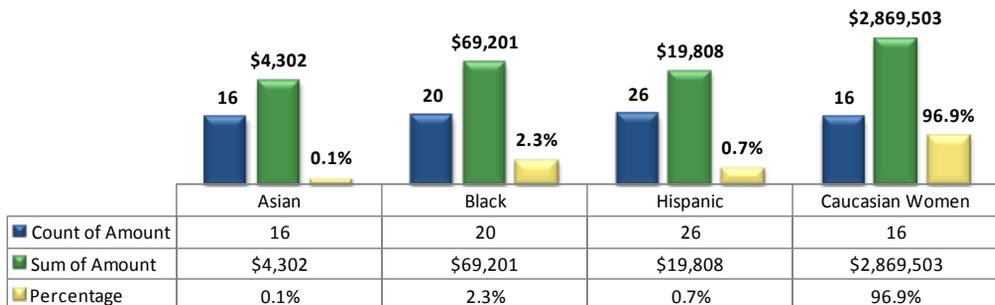

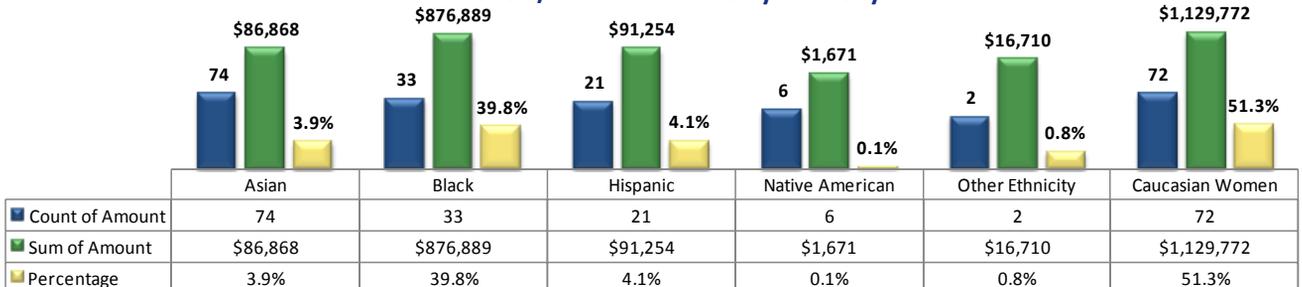

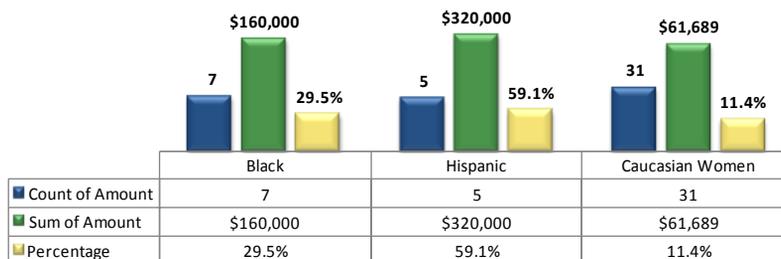

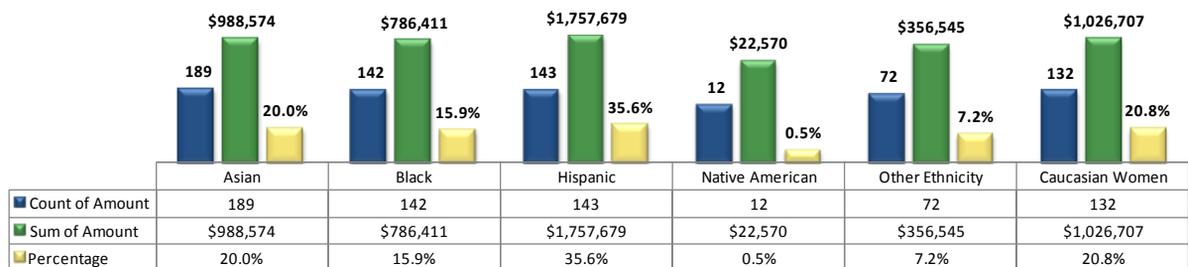

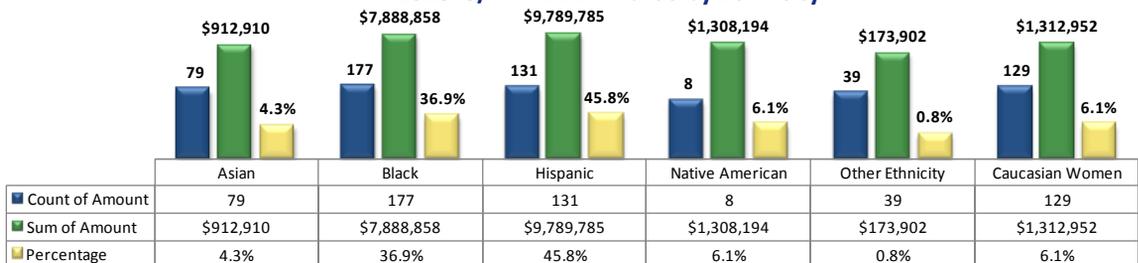

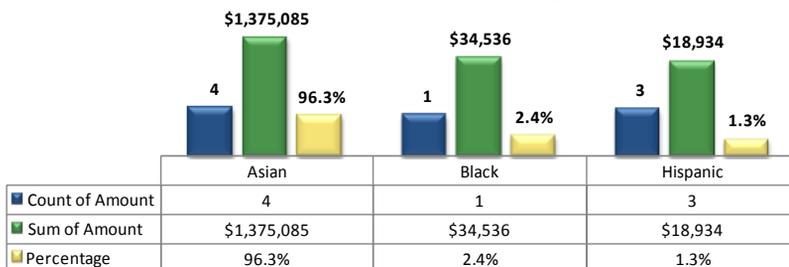

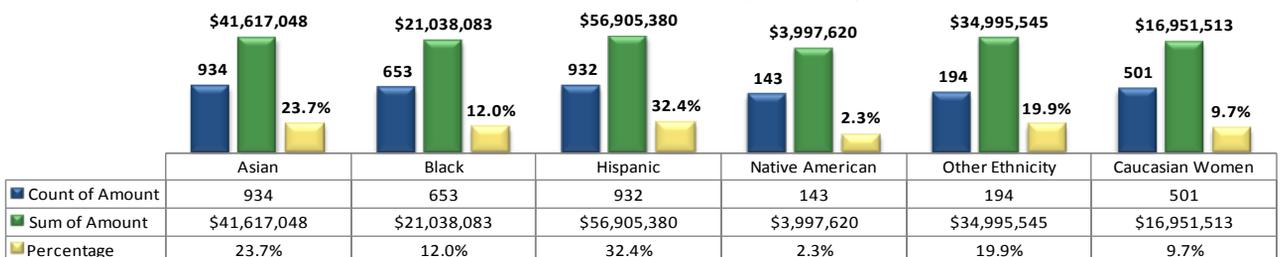

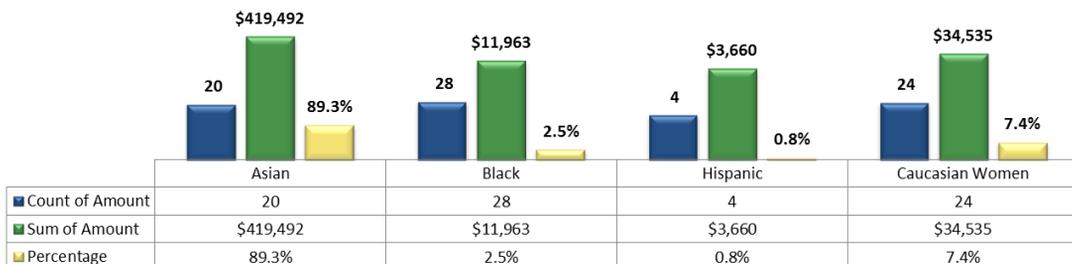

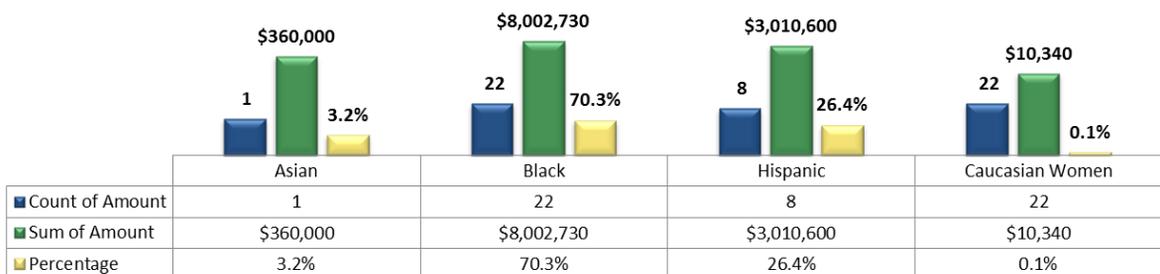

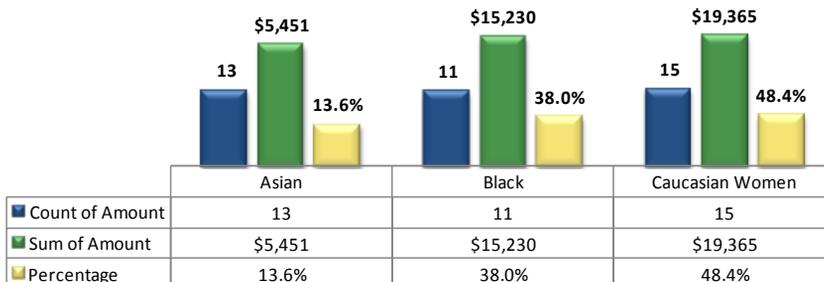

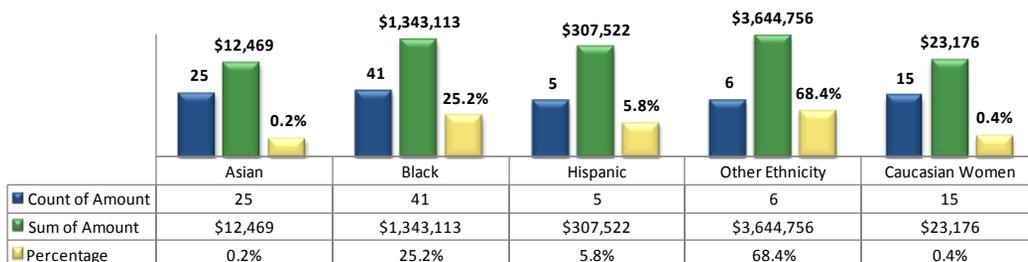

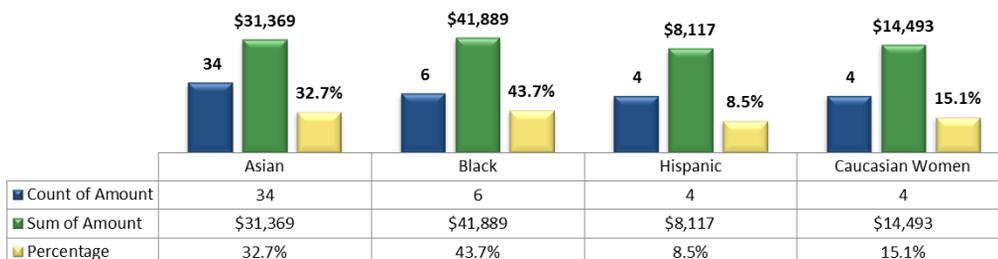

- For FY2013, the Houston Parks and Recreation Department (PRD) awarded \$9,202,189 to certified and non-certified firms. However, from this amount \$1,437,626 were non goal-oriented and \$881,766 were exempt contracts. Out of the remaining total of \$6,882,797, a total of \$817,505 was awarded to certified firms, amounting to a 11.9% utilization.
- The purchasing total of \$6,882,797 included: \$1,761,530 for purchase orders, \$4,086,985 for purchasing contracts and \$1,034,283 in p-card transactions.
- The exempt contracts total of \$881,766 included contracts worth \$681,766 where a waiver was granted by the Office of Business Opportunity and \$200,000 were exempt contracts without waivers.

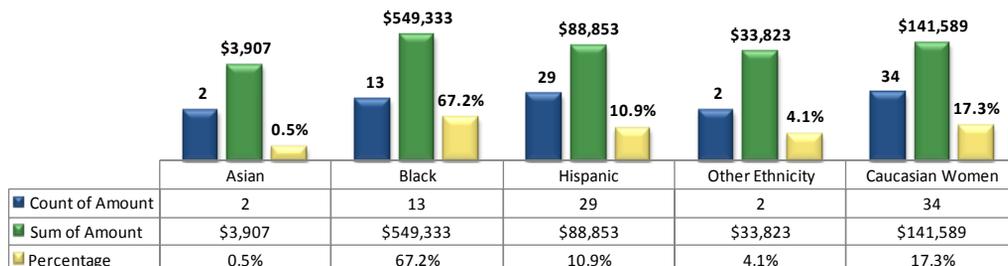

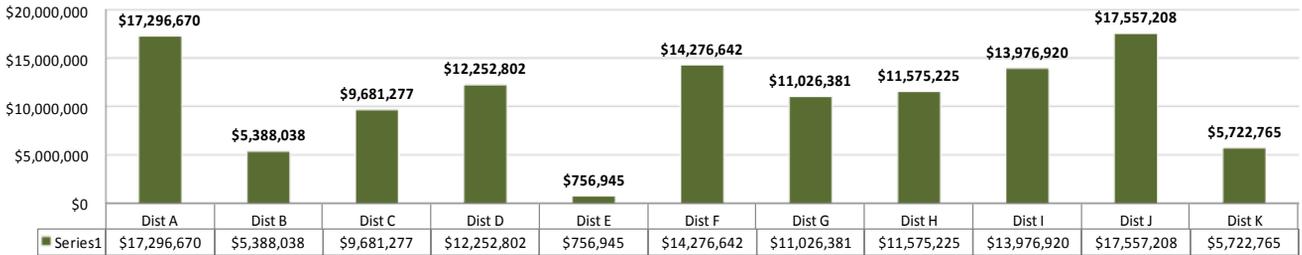
