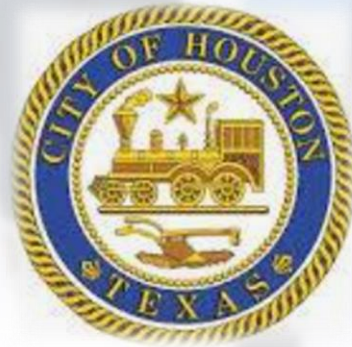

Super Neighborhoods Grant Program

- **What is the Super Neighborhoods Grant Program?**

The grant helps stimulate neighborhoods by offering reimbursement funds for various beautification and improvement projects

Annual SNGP Benefits & Reimbursements

• Benefits

- Opportunity to improve your community!
- Be involved and build personal relations!
- Establish *new traditions to make an impact!*
- Provides a sense of purpose and teaches valuable skills!

• Reimbursements

- Refund on your spendings starting at \$500 to \$7000 per Super Neighborhood!
- Helps pay for physical improvements or projects throughout communities!
- Empower SNs to beautify the neighborhoods for attraction!

How *may* Super Neighborhood(s) use the funds?

The funds may be used for Neighborhood Improvement Project(s)

Project Initiatives

- ❖ **Streetscaping** – improve the appearance of streets with landscaping and/or street furniture
- ❖ **Community Gardens** – establish garden in underutilized spaces, fostering a sense of community and providing fresh produce
- ❖ **Murals and/or signage** – paint image to blank wall(s) or building to add color, cultural or artistic expression
- ❖ **Tree(s) Installations** – install trees and other greenery throughout street median(s) and esplanades(s) to enhance the aesthetic appeal and create a more inviting environment
- ❖ **Irrigation Installation** – manage water usage efficiently
- ❖ **Walkways with pavers** - including enhanced curb appeal, durability, low maintenance, and improved drainage
- ❖ **Super Neighborhood other event(s)**, ask for more details

Cash transactions or in-kind services (food, materials, volunteers or equipment) cannot be submitted for reimbursement.

Super Neighborhood(s) Must Haves...

1. The Super Neighborhood must be an “**Active**” Super Neighborhood with an updated By-Law(s).
2. Super Neighborhood Vendor must be registered as a City of Houston Vendor via the Strategic Purchasing Procurement Division. [Strategic Procurement Division](#)

3. Must have a checking account and an elected Treasurer or Secretary who is responsible for using taxpayer funds in good faith.
4. Must have a physical address or P.O. Box for mailing.
5. *Organization must be filed as a 503(c) or 501 (c)(4) without PAC (Political Action Committee)*

- _____ 1. Register as a COH vendor through the Strategic Purchasing Procurement Division, 832.393.8800.

- _____ 2. Submit the COH Super Neighborhood Grant Program 2026 Application and required documents by the deadline, **October 6, 2025**.
- _____ 3. Starting on **October 31, 2025**, MAO will deliver the SNGP Approval Award Letter(s) to the organizations.
- _____ 4. Initiate and complete your project(s) by **May 18, 2026**.
- _____ 5. Organization will pay the vendor(s) for completed project(s). ***No reimbursement for incomplete or past due projects!***
- _____ 6. Submit all the original receipts, invoices and/or cancelled checks with the MAO Invoice Form for payment.
MAO must receive receipts within 5 business days of the completed project.
- _____ 7. MAO will review the payment request and process for payment within 30 business days of receipt.

FAQs...



Q. What is the Super Neighborhood Grants Program (SNGP)?

A. The SNGP is a program designed to benefit, beautify and improve the neighborhoods.



Q. Who is eligible to qualify for the Super Neighborhood Grants Program?

A. Active Super Neighborhoods with Department of Neighborhoods approved and update by-laws.



Q. Where can I apply for the SNGP Initiative Program Application?

A. The application will be available starting August 26, 2025, contact the Mayor's Assistance Office at 832.393.0955 or the Council Liaison.



Q. What is the deadline to submit an application?

A. The deadline to submit an application this year is Monday, October 6, 2025, by 5:00P.M.



Q. When can I start the neighborhood project?

A. The project can start **AFTER** your SN Organization receives the award letter notification from MAO.



Q. How to become a vendor with City of Houston?

A. Go to **Strategic Procurement Division** and register as a COH vendor through the Strategic Purchasing Procurement Division, for more information call 832.393.8800
